Will B. stated, "Good Afternoon fellow travelers. I am pleased to report that CSASC H&I Subcommittee continues to function at a satisfactory pace at the Seabrook House Womens' Group and Cumberland County Department of Corrections. Despite time away for vacations and cook-outs, the subcommittee has managed to make at least 8 presentations to at least 214 participants, with most at Seabrook House weekly meetings and at least 3 at the Cumberland Corrections Unit. The scope of the Seabrook group engages many women who are gaining in curiosity about NA. The Cumberland DOC presentation continues to have positive involvement from inmates with questions and sometimes sharing their experience, strength, and hope. It is with sadness that I report one of our earlier presenters has decided to leave the committee. We thank them for their service to this effort.

With regard to the proposed presentation at the soon-to-open detox facility, at the Inspira Medical facility in Bridgeton, we have been advised that their proposed opening will be delayed until after September, 2018. Our volunteers remain committed to the effort, once the facility certifications issue is resolved. The subcommittee does not need any expenditures for literature at this time, due to some of them purchasing their own literature. 
